# 48 temples in TN will live stream opening of donation boxes, HC told

The Tamil Nadu government recently told the Madras High Court that forty-eight 'Senior Grade' temples in the State have been directed to live stream the opening of their donation boxes on their respective YouTube channels.

The Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments (HR&CE) department of the State government made the submission in a counter affidavit filed in a case involving concerns of irregularities in the management of temple funds.

The matter is being heard by a bench of Chief Justice SV Gangapurwala and Justice Bharatha Chakravarthy.

The HR&CE department informed the Court that the State has issued a circular instructing forty-eight Senior Grade temples to live stream the opening of their donation boxes and to comply with the provisions of the installation, Safeguarding and Accounting of Hundial Rules of 1975.

The Court was hearing a batch of public interest litigation pleas filed by Rangarajan Narasimhan who moved the Court highlighting instances of theft of cash and gold ornaments from donation boxes.

The State told the Court that once the donation boxes are opened, detailed records of all cash, ornaments and all other articles found inside are prepared immediately by the temple authorities.

It also submitted that often such boxes are opened in the presence of the general public and the temple register containing records of donations is signed by two members of the general public each time new entries are made.

The Court recorded the State's submissions and posted the matter for further hearing on January 11, 2024.

Additional security forces have been deployed near the temples in the village." Earlier, irate residents blocked NH-75 and other roads for 8 hours in protest at Mudma village, 30-km from Ranchi, on Thursday night.

## Naked bodies of foreign couple with injury marks found in HP

The naked bodies of a couple believed to be from Russia were found at a small pond near the holy town of Manikaran in Himachal's Kullu, police said on Friday.

The bodies found on Thursday bore injury marks. Police said it appeared to be a case of suicide, but did not rule out possibility of murder. Police said the man and woman, who were in their 20s, based on their belongings, could be from Russia.

Naked bodies of the woman and man were found in a hot spring pool and outside the pool, respectively in Tagri on banks of Parvati river, about 2 km from Manikaran. ASP Sanjeev Chauhan said the man bore cut marks on his hand and neck, while the woman had injury marks on her hand. Their injuries were not fatal and cause of death is yet to be ascertained.
